Communion

When directed by an Usher, please come forward using the center aisle and kneel or stand at the altar rail. You will receive the bread then the wine. Grape juice & gluten free wafers are available upon request. Children who do not yet commune receive a blessing. Once you have been served, please return to your pew by the side aisles. If you are unable to come forward but wish to receive communion, let an Usher know and communion will be brought to you.

Mission of the Month COMPASSION INTERNATIONAL

Compassion International exists as an advocate for children, to release them from their spiritual, economic, social and physical poverty and enable them to become responsible and fulfilled Christian adults. This is done in a variety of ways. For the Calvary Congregation, we are most familiar with their Water of Life and Child Sponsorship programs.

In prior years, our focus has been on the Water of Life program to purchase water filtration systems. Thankfully, this program has been so successful that there is a limit of how many new systems they need each year. The Water of Life program is part of the larger "WaSH" program which stands for Water Sanitation and Hygiene. Donations directed to WaSH might be used for Water of Life but if all the units have already been acquired for the year, the funds would be used for wells, filtration systems, water storage or sanitation facilities. In 2010, the North American Lutheran Church was formed, and in its Confession of Faith is included a "Common Confession", first adopted by the Lutheran Coalition for Renewal (CORE) in 2005. That Common Confession has seven parts and they are:

- The Lord Jesus Christ
- The Gospel of Salvation
- The Authority of Scripture
- A Common Confession of Faith (pertaining to the Lutheran Confessions and other church bodies)
- The Priesthood of All Believers
- Marriage and Family
- The Mission and Ministry of the Congregation.

Sola Publishing, the official publishing house of the NALC, has produced a study guide that will help participants understand the origin and implication of these seven statements. This study resource, which began on Wednesday, March 6 will form the basis of our sessions and the study guide is available for purchase (not required to participate) for \$10, payable to Calvary Lutheran Church. Confirmation Camp (Lutherdale) – June 16-21

This year, Calvary confirmation students will be headed to Camp Lutherdale for confirmation camp. This week of camp is set aside for churches to bring their students for an immersive week of faith and fun with worship centered on the sacraments, small group bible study with your church and much more. High School Mission Trip – July 6-13

This year, the high school students will be traveling to Pocahontas, VA to repair homes through Group Mission Trips. We'll repair porches, patch roofs, shore up existing structures, and serve where it's needed most in this small community of about 441. We will leave Calvary Saturday July 6 and return

July 13. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due at sign up. Though the registration is \$464, thanks to generous support from members of Calvary, the total **cost per student is \$250**. Checks can be made out to Calvary (with Mission Trip in the memo line) and given to Kyle Jones. *The trip is open for students entering high school (8th graders) through graduating seniors.*

Calvary at Lutherdale – July 7-12

It has been our tradition to pick a week in the summer for children and students of Calvary to go to Camp Lutherdale together. This summer that will be July 7-12. That week is open to all age campers kindergarten through high school. The theme for that week will be *Water Week* which means the week will be filled with lakefront activities like swimming, canoeing, pontoon boats and the water slide, wet and wild camp games like kiddie pool kickball, and Water Olympics. The total cost per student is \$250 for the full week and \$125 for the half week. Calvary will cover the remainder of the cost. Scholarships are available.
