NEW BIBLE STUDY SERIES

In 2010, the North American Lutheran Church was formed, and in its Confession of Faith is included a "Common Confession", first adopted by the Lutheran Coalition for Renewal (CORE) in 2005. That Common Confession has seven parts and they are:

- The Lord Jesus Christ
- The Gospel of Salvation
- The Authority of Scripture
- A Common Confession of Faith (pertaining to the Lutheran Confessions and other church bodies)
- The Priesthood of All Believers
- Marriage and Family
- The Mission and Ministry of the Congregation.

Sola Publishing, the official publishing house of the NALC, has produced a study guide that will help participants understand the origin and implication of these seven statements. This study resource will form the basis of our sessions and the study guide is available for purchase (not required to participate) for \$10, payable to Calvary Lutheran. Pastor Ken will have copies of this study guide or you can pick up one from the office.
