Thursday, September 20 at 11:00 a.m.

If you're 60 or older - or even if you're not, but this sounds interesting to you - we hope you can join us for a program devoted to your eyes, all of our aging eyes.

We'll begin in the sanctuary with a short DVD introducing our topic for the day, age-related macular degeneration (AMD). This is a health issue that affects nearly all of us seniors at

some point, whether it's watching for early indicators or dealing with the actual disease.

At 11:45 a.m. we'll enjoy a light lunch in Fellowship Hall (free will offering), and at 12:15 p.m. we'll be joined by Dr. Mackenzie Sward from Milwaukee Eye Care for an explanation of AMD and an update on current treatments. There will be time for questions of Dr. Sward after her presentation.
