Mission of the Month -February Lutheran Bible Translators

Lutheran Bible Translators in partnership with Wycliffe Bible Translators plays a huge role in the growth of Christians in Africa. Since founded in 1964, Bible translators have brought literacy and Christ's Good News of Salvation to millions. To translate the Bible to "Languages of the Heart" - the language of an indigenous people, requires first learning the language by immersing translators in the villages. Then CREATING a written language, and finally translating the New Testament into the people's language...of their heart. Currently there are over 80 missionaries translating the New Testament into 26 indigenous languages for Africa.
