Sunday Studies

Individual Devotion

One way we grow in our relationship with God is to regularly spend time with God in prayer and to grow in our knowledge of his word, the Bible. How, exactly, do we do this?

There are a variety of individual devotional guides. Use the one that works best for you! Two that you will hear mentioned at Calvary are:

Jesus Calling by Sarah Young and/or Jesus Always by Sarah Young These books are a free gift to you and are available in the Narthex on the book table. Simply turn to the reading for today's date and spend a few minutes reading that section. If you have a little extra time, you can look up the readings listed for each entry. Once you're done reading, spend a few moments and quietly ask God what He'd like you to learn from this reading. Thank God for the blessings and gifts you can see in your life, and ask God for guidance or healing in areas where you need his hand of guidance and grace. Do it again tomorrow!

M'Cheyne Reading Guide

In the eighteenth century, Robert Murray M Cheyne devised a daily readings schedule which covers the entire Bible in one year! Each day, 4 readings are assigned. If you read all 4, you'll read through the entire Bible in a year! If you only read the last reading assigned for each day, you'll read through the Psalms and New Testament in a year!! Sunday School for Children and Youth

1st, 2nd and 3rd Grade

Though our 1st through 3rd Grade students still have fun playing, they also learn how to look up Bible verses! As they study the scriptures, they become even more familiar with Biblical events and they grow in their faith and relationship with Christ.

Third Grade students will have a Bible Class with Pastor Ken on Sunday, October 8 at 11:30 a.m. and receive their *Adventure Bible* on Sunday, October 15 during worship. These Bibles are a gift from the Christian Education Committee.

4th and 5th Grade

Our 4th and 5th Grade students learn how to look up scripture verse *and* learn how to start with a topic and find verses about that topic!

Fourth Graders also prepare to take their First Communion on March 18, 2018 during worship. The First Communion Prep class will be on Sunday, March 11, 2018.

Middle School Confirmation

Taught by Pastor Ken and Pastor Dawn Room 107

Our Middle Schoolers participate in a three year Confirmation program in which students are taught what we as Christians believe. We will study the Scriptures, the Creed, Lord's Prayer and Ten Commandments. We will learn with it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ and a Lutheran.

Confirmation students attend class weekly during the Sunday School year. Additionally, they will complete sermon notes and assist as acolytes in worship.

Eighth Grade students who profess their faith in Christ and desire to become a Confirmed member of Calvary Lutheran Church will be Confirmed on May 20, 2018 during Sunday Worship.

High School

Taught by Pastor Dan Spies Room 112 (Youth Room)

Our High School students meet on Sundays to wrestle together with how their faith and the world intersect. Through study, video, conversation and prayer our students learn and grow in faith.

Sunday School Staff

Our Sunday School staff is strictly voluntary. Sunday School teachers are recruited from our worshiping community. Training and materials are provided. Adult congregation members of all ages are encouraged to share their time & talents with our children. A thorough multi-state background check has been completed on all Sunday School volunteers.

Sunday School Benevolence

Giving is an important lesson we can share with our youth early in their Christian Education. Again this year, all Sunday School giving will be for the purchase of animals with the Heifer International to end hunger and poverty.

New this year — youth "noisy offerings" will be collected as part of the Children's Sermon on Sundays during worship.





Pick Up—Drop Off Procedures

Calvary's Sunday School will use the following Pick Up—Drop Off Procedure for Children's Sunday School. The goal is to keep drop off and pick up orderly and prevent children and parents from missing one another in the hallways.

Drop Off Procedure

We ask that parents bring their children, especially those preK through 3rd Grade, to their classroom and check in with their Sunday School teacher.

Pick Up Procedure

Parents, especially those preK through 3rd Grade, are to pick up their children directly from their classroom. If your child has an older sibling that will be picking him/her up, please let your child's teacher know.

In addition to safety issues, this policy also prevents our children from walking through the halls unsupervised before and after class.

This dismissal process will be most beneficial to children in grades Pre-K through 3rd, but we encourage pick up for all grades. We ask that both parents and teachers pay close attention to the time of dismissal.

Behavior Guidelines

The goal of the Children's Ministry program is to provide an environment conducive to learning the basics of faith. The means for meeting this goal are effective curriculum, appropriate staffing and engaging activities. We also pray that through these elements we may be a vehicle by which God's love is conveyed and a personal faith enhanced.

Expectations

1. RESPECT: God, Yourself and Others

This means that we will seek to put the needs of others first. For example: We keep our hands to ourselves and we do not run in the building if others are still using the building.

2. BE WHERE YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE

When it's time for Sunday School or Youth Group, be with your class. Make sure your parents know where you are and that you have permission and supervision on the playground and in the game room.

3. ASK FIRST

Before you use anything, go anywhere, or do anything apart from your class, simply ask first.

Consequences

- 1. Warning remind a child of rules and expectations through redirection.
- It is left to the adult or teacher's discretion whether the child needs separation from the group. If so, a "time out" may be used where the child sits in a chair alone inside the classroom. A parent or guardian may also be notified to come and assist in the classroom.
- 3. Contact the parent or guardian of the student. They may choose to assist in the classroom or take the child home for the day.
- 4. Refer to the Interim Director of Youth & Family or Pastor for follow-up with the teacher, parent and child.

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Youth Sundays

Throughout the year, Youth Sundays are held to allow students to serve in Worship, to have fun and further grow their faith. Youth Sundays will generally meet from 11:30 a.m.—1:30 p.m. and start with a potluck lunch for all followed by a large group activity and then



break out for small youth groups below. Any student may participate and friends are always welcome.

<u>Littlest Lutherans (preK—2nd Grade)</u>

Our youngest students and their parent(s) will gather for some fun before sharing in a time of prayer. This small group meeting will be part of Youth Sunday activities.

3rd—5th Grade Youth Group

Our 3rd—5th Grade students will meet as part of Youth Sunday activities. We will play, study and pray. This laid back setting allows the "older" kids to build relationships among themselves as well as strengthening their relationship with their Lord.

Middle School Youth Group

Middle School students study together in Confirmation and have an opportunity to play, serve and bond during Youth Sundays. Students will meet for games, devotion and prayer!
