Mission of the Month - June NALC Disaster Response Fund Lutheran World Relief

The NALC Disaster Response Fund provides resources to respond to domestic natural disaster, working through local NALC congregations, as well as other compatible disaster relief organizations.

Lutheran World Relief (LWR) works to improve harvest, health and education in 35 countries each year. LWR partners train local men and women to produce local foods, dig low-cost wells and protect and restore their local environments.
