Thank God for the blessings and gifts you can see in your life, and ask God for guidance or healing in areas where you need his hand of guidance and grace. Do it again tomorrow!

• M'Cheyne Reading Guide

In the eighteenth century, Robert Murray M Cheyne devised a daily readings schedule which covers the entire Bible in one year! Each day, 4 readings are assigned. If you read all 4, you'll read through the entire Bible in a year! If you only read the last reading assigned for each day, you'll read through the Psalms and New Testament in a year!! No matter how much time you have, you'll get something awesome out of this simply reading plan. **The September and October sheet will be available in the Narthex**. <u>4th and 5th Grade</u>

4th Graders also prepare to take their First Communion on April 2, 2017 during worship. The First Communion Prep class will be on March 26, 2017 from 11:30a-2:00p.

Middle School Confirmation

Taught by Pastor Dawn with Adam Kershek (Sub: Larry Bonier) Room

Our Middle Schoolers participate in a three year Confirmation program in which students are taught what we as Christian believe. We will study the Scriptures, the Creed, Lord's Prayer and Ten Commandments. We will learn with it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ and a Lutheran.

Confirmation students attend class weekly during the Sunday School year. Additionally, they will complete sermon notes and assist as acolytes in worship.

8th Grade students who profess their faith in Christ and desire to become a Confirmed member of Calvary Lutheran will be Confirmed on May 21, 2017 during Sunday Worship.

<u>High School</u>

Taught by Pastor Dan Spies (Sub: Larry Bonier) Room

Our High School students meet on Sundays to wrestle together with how their faith and the world interest. Through study, video, conversation and prayer our students learn and grow in faith.

Sunday School Staff

Our Sunday School staff is strictly voluntary. Sunday School teachers are recruited from our worshiping community. Training and materials are provided. Adult congregation members of all ages are encouraged to share their time & talents with our children. All volunteers have completed a thorough multi-state background check.

Pick Up—Drop Off Procedures

Calvary's Sunday School will use the following Pick Up—Drop Off Procedure for Children's Sunday School. The goal is to keep drop off and pick up orderly and prevent children and parents from missing one another in the hallways.

Drop Off Procedure

We ask that parents bring their children, especially those preK through 3rd Grade, to their classroom and check in with their Sunday School teacher.

Pick Up Procedure

Parents, especially those preK through 3rd Grade, are to pick up their children directly from their classroom. If your child has an older sibling that will be picking him/her up, please let your child's teacher know.

In addition to safety issues, this policy also prevents our children from walking through the halls unsupervised before after class.

This dismissal process will be most beneficial to children in grades Pre-K through 3rd, but we encourage pick up for all grades. We ask that both parents and teachers pay close attention to the time of dismissal.

Behavior Guidelines

The goal of the Children's Ministry program is to provide an environment conducive to learning the basics of faith. The means for meeting this goal are effective curriculum, appropriate staffing and engaging activities. We also pray that through these elements we may be a vehicle by which God's love is conveyed and a personal faith enhanced.

Expectations

1. RESPECT: God, Yourself and Others

This mean that we will seek to put the needs of others first. For example: We keep our hands to ourselves and we do not run in the building if others are still using the building.

2. BE WHERE YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE

When it's time for Sunday School or Youth Group, be with your class. Make sure your parent know where you are and that you have permission and supervision on the playground and in the game room.

3. ASK FIRST

Before you use anything, go anywhere, or do anything apart from your class, simply ask first.

Consequences

- 1. Warning remind a child of rules and expectations through redirection.
- 2. It is left to the adult or teacher's discretion whether the child needs separation from the group. If so, a "time out" may be used where the child sits in a chair alone inside the classroom. A parent or guardian may also be notified to come and assist in the classroom.
- 3. Contact the parent or guardian of the student. They may choose to assist in the classroom or take the child home for the day.
- 4. Refer to the Director of Youth & Family Ministries or Pastor for follow-up with the teacher, parent and child.

Youth Groups

Throughout the year, youth groups are held to allow students to have fun and further grow their faith. The following Youth Groups are offered at Calvary. Any student may participate and friends are always welcome.

Littlest Lutherans (preK—2nd Grade)

A few time a year, our youngest students and their families will gather for an event. We have a few *PJs and Prayers* events planned, were students and families will gather to watch a short movie and have some fun before sharing in a time of prayer. We will also gather a few times after Sunday School for lunch and a game, just like the big kids do!

<u>3rd—5th Grade Youth Group</u>

Our 3rd—5th Grade students will meet after Sunday School, once a monthly from 11:30—1pm in the Fellowship Hall. We will eat, play, study and pray. This laid back setting allows the "older" kids to build relationships among themselves as well as strengthening their relationship with their Lord.

Middle School Youth Group

Middle School students study together in Confirmation and have an opportunity to play, serve and bond during Youth Group. Students will meet for games, devotion and prayer!

Parents will play a vital role in assisting with events, driving and participating. You can bring a friend or two too!
