
Our mission at Calvary is to boldly proclaim the life-changing love of Jesus Christ through joyful worship, faithful service, & continuous learning.

This month Calvary's mission focus is on education. Donations will be used to support the two components of one NALC Seminary system: a Seminary Center at Trinity School for Ministry in Ambridge, Pa., and Houses of Studies located within NALC Mission Districts, as well as supporting Calvary college students either attending a Lutheran college or pursuing a degree in an area of ministry. Education is important for the continuation of our Biblical centeredness and for providing a place with resources to support our congregations, clergy and teachers. The establishment of a seminary to provide for the theological education of future pastors for the North American Lutheran Church was approved at the annual NALC Convocation last year.
