
Our mission at Calvary is to boldly proclaim the life-changing love of Jesus Christ through joyful worship, faithful service, & continuous learning.

Missions

February Mission of the Month: Lutheran Bible Translators

Lutherans started LBT in 1964 to make God's Word accessible to everyone—literate or not, educated or not—in the language of their hearts. Fewer than 550 of the more than 7,000 languages in the world have translations of the complete Bible. Fewer than 1,300 have a translated New Testament. That means about 180 million people today do not have any Scripture available in their



language. Why not teach these people English and give them an English Bible? Because messages are communicated best in a person's mother tongue, or 'heart language'. The hearer or reader can process the information on an emotional *heart-felt* level, rather than just an intellectual one. In addition to written translations, LBT communicates Scripture audio-visually and is involved in Scripture Engagement and literacy programs.

LBT is supported solely by churches, church organizations and by individuals with a heart for missions. Calvary has had an on-going relationship with LBT and specifically with the Federwitz families and the Burmeisters. You can read updates from the families on our bulletin board in Fellowship Hall and biographies will be featured in a bulletin insert each week during February.

We invite you to prayerfully consider supporting LBT and the spread of the Gospel message to people around the world. Use your weekly offering envelopes or a white pew envelope to contribute and note "Mission of the Month" on your check and/or envelope.
