- When you switch with or fill in for someone else (whether planned or in case of a “no show”), please note it on the schedule posted in the acolyte closet. We want to keep track of actual service to make sure it is equitable.
- When you are scheduled to acolyte, please be on time. You should be in your robe and ready to go at least 10 minutes prior to the worship service.
- Please hang up your robe neatly after the completion of the worship service.
- We ask that you be conscious of your footwear when serving as an acolyte, as your shoes do show under the robe. You are in the service of our Lord and should dress appropriately. No flip flops or ratty tennis shoes, please.
- When searching for a sub, e-mail is a good option to get the word out to everyone, but realize that phone calls are often the best method to reach people and get an answer, especially on short notice.
