Youth Fundraiser

This year we're doing something new that gives Calvary the opportunity to support its students monetarily, physically and spiritually. How can we do all three at the same time?

Here's how: We have a clear reusable water bottle with a specially designed Youth & Family Ministry decal for each student (20 in all) attending either summer camp, confirmation camp, or mission trip. Attached to each water bottle is a prayer card for a specific student.

For \$100 you'll help to offset the cost for the students participating in those summer experiences. You will receive the prayer card for the individual student to use to pray for them this summer and that student will get the water bottle to use at summer camp, confirmation camp, or mission trip. The front of each prayer card has an individual student's name, birthday, and grade as well as what their summer experience will be.
