"Make a joyful noise to the Lord all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing." Psalm 100:1-2 (NIV)

Kyle Jones and I recently spent a week teaching about Lutheran liturgy (worship) at Lutherdale Bible Camp to members of our confirmation class. It's not hard to find an opening devotion for such an endeavor – just let your Bible fall open to the Psalms and chances are pretty good that on the page in front of you will be words about worship – prayer, praise, thanksgiving. Phrases like "make a joyful noise...shout to the Lord...I lift up my eyes...Give thanks to the Lord... I will sing of your love" are all over the place.

Most of you know the Psalms as the "hymnbook of the Old Testament." Many of them will come with an annotation such as "to the director of music" or "a song of ascents." Some come with even more context. Psalm 51, a psalm of confession, begins; "A psalm of David; when the prophet Nathan came to him after David had committed adultery with Bathsheba." Psalm 45 begins; "To the tune of Lilies...a Wedding Song."

While not much is known about the precise format of early Christian worship – both Colossians and Ephesians exhort believers to "sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs in your heart with gratitude to God." It's hard to separate worship and singing – it may well be impossible. A distinction is sometimes drawn between congregational hymns, which vary from week to week, and "service music" which is consistent from week to week (i.e., those sung portions of the liturgy such as the Kyrie "Lord have mercy" or Agnus Dei "Lamb of God").

Lutheran service music is often paraphrases of Scripture or prayers put to music. Hymns can be as well, and indeed often are – but they also can be personal testimonies or written for, or as a result of a specific event (think the explanations for Psalm 45 and 51). Digging behind the scenes you can discover fascinating stories that inspired the writers of our modern hymns.

In the month of July, I plan to depart from my usual custom of basing my messages solely on a particular Scripture, and instead offer a series of reflections on great hymns of the church. Our series is entitled "*Hymns: History and Theology*" and the four hymns I've selected as the focus will be:

- "It Is Well With My Soul" (also known as "When Peace, Like a River") by Horatio Spafford
- "Blessed Assurance" by Fanny Crosby
- "Be Thou My Vision" of old Irish origin later translated by Mary Byrne and Eleanor Hull
- "Holy, Holy, Holy" by Reginald Heber.

Aided by summations of the lives and what we know of their inspiration of these authors for writing (hymn histories which we'll see on video each week), my hope is that we'll gain greater appreciation of how Christian hymns, like the Psalms from which they arise, are earthy, honest expressions of faith that do double duty – leading the church in prayer, praise and thanksgiving to God.

Pastor Nijhar and Pastor Neeraj serve in India where they are joined in mission by their four children. They have lived in India most of their lives and feel blessed to minister there. Together, they serve in the North Western Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church, primarily at Navin Doman Theological College. The college was established in 2007 and is training pastors and lay leaders from several states throughout the region. They are also praying and working to start a boarding school for quality education for children in the village. This school will prepare leaders for the next generation.

Our continued prayers and financial support are important for the continuation of this vital outreach in India. ### WOMEN'S BOOK GROUP - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9


We're beginning our year by reading <u>Being Mortal</u>: <u>Medicine and What Matters in the End</u> by Atul Gawande.
