#### Communion

All those who are baptized and believe that Christ is present in this meal are welcome to receive communion with us.

When directed by an Usher, please come forward using the center aisle and kneel or stand at the altar rail. You will receive the bread then the wine. (Grape juice & gluten free wafers are available upon request.) Children who do not yet commune will receive a blessing. Once you have been served, please return to your pew by the side aisles. If you are unable to come forward but wish to receive communion, let an Usher know and communion will be brought to you.

July's mission of the month is one of the North American Lutheran Church's ministry partners working in India, World Mission Prayer League. The global workers we are sponsoring are Pastor Nijhar and Pastor Neeraj. Pastor Nelson and Marcella became friends of Pastor Nijhar and Pastor Neeraj when they studied at Luther Seminary at the same time as Pastor Nelson. Pastor Nijhar and Pastor Neeraj serve in India where they are joined in mission by their four children. They have lived in India most of their lives and feel blessed to minister there. Together, they serve in the North Western Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church, primarily at Navin Doman Theological College. The college was established in 2007 and is training pastors, and lay leaders from several states throughout the region. Our continued prayers and financial support are important for the continuation of this vital outreach in India. Mission of the Month offerings will be used to support the seminary and to start a boarding school for needy village children to provide quality education and outreach!


