Checks can be made out to Calvary (with Mission Trip in the memo line) and given to Kyle Jones. The trip is open for students entering high school (8th graders) through graduating seniors.

Calvary at Lutherdale – July 7-12

It has been our tradition to pick a week in the summer for children and students of Calvary to go to Camp Lutherdale together. This summer that will be July 7-12. That week is open to all age campers kindergarten through high school.
